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Preface

The idea of compiling a bibliography on Mono Lake Basin came to me in 1976 while I was conducting research in Yosemite National Park. There I studied subalpine ecosystems and their history, ecology, and distribution. I was impressed by the extent to which I had to search in institutional nooks and crannies to find out about the existence of valuable documents. I was dismayed that other researchers had to do the same thing, if their work was to be thorough. More importantly, it was evident that many researchers did not have the means or time to do in depth research and they were at a disadvantage.

When my scientific interests focused on Mono Lake Basin, I realized that there was a large volume of literature which would make a nearly comprehensive bibliography. I realized what a service it would be to provide a bibliography that would give researchers a solid start on the relevant literature about the Mono Lake Basin.

A comprehensive bibliography is a document that can be of service to researchers for all time. It establishes the existence of many documents and increases the chances that they will be saved. Often only single copies of valuable historic documents are available. By making people aware of their existence, the documents will be made accessible and useful.

It is unfortunate that there is no library about the Mono Lake Basin. Despite the overlapping interests, responsibilities, and informational needs of several associated groups and individuals, no one has taken the initiative to create one publicly accessible collection. Now, at least in having this bibliography complete, it is known what materials should be available. Unfortunately, it still may be difficult for researchers to locate the documents.

I hope this bibliography will help researchers to locate the best tools available. Among these are imagery, either photographic or remotely sensed imagery; aerial and landscape photographs are irreplaceable tools for understanding an environment and its history. In addition, Master's theses are in a bibliographic void, consistently absent from printed or electronic bibliographies; their informational contribution, if exploited, is considerable. And maps, the eternal guide, are made a little more visible by means of this publication.

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Due to the disparate status of electronic spatial data (space imagery) it really isn't feasible to include much here; it is more suitable for inclusion in the cartographically-based and image-based electronic bibliographies of the future. At present, remotely-sensed information is simply not a part of the information mainstream because of the expense of acquiring it, the complexity of gaining access, and the lack of public tools (computers with image processing software) for working with the information.

As a geographer and a librarian, I was intrigued by the notion of making a comprehensive bibliography for a place. As expected, the bibliography shows disconcerting omissions in our compilation of knowledge about Mono Lake Basin. And we find stereotypical approaches to particular subjects, for example trees viewed mainly as a source of timber. We also find emphases on particular minutia because of scientists' predilections toward certain topics for which there are abundant publication outlets. On other topics, often of greater ecological or historical importance, research and writing has been neglected and there seems to be little opportunity to publish. There is also a paucity of literature on those topics to which modern science is not well suited, such as measures of visual resources or the value of recreation.

The disposition of particular types of records are unfortunate. A lot of information is dispersed in private hands or tucked away in office files. One can only conclude that much information of incalculable future value will be and has already been lost. Often the institutional knowledge of the existence and importance of certain documents disappears with the retirement or departure of certain employees. Often valuable documents are purged simply due to ignorance and a space shortage. Again, we arrive back at the need for an archive/library for this material. Such a facility could utilize modern electronics to store and distribute these materials in a very efficient way without depriving the document owners of their originals. As a librarian, I feel compelled to express additional concern over those documents which are not available to the researcher, even within public or quasi-public agencies. Part of this is secrecy, but much can be attributed to disorganization. From an informational point-of-view, this is a tragedy. From the viewpoint of a democracy, it is an abandonment of our mutual obligation to preserve information and to provide information to each other.

It is my hope that this bibliography will assist researchers to easily comprehend what information is available on Mono Lake Basin and allow them to spend more time on the land and the Lake-exploring its mysteries and finding inspiration. It is my greatest hope that this document will somehow lead to the creation of a public library specifically on Mono Lake Basin.

The landscape of library research has transformed dramatically since 1991, driven primarily by the digital revolution. In the early 1990s, when Daniel Holmes was finishing compiling this bibliography, researchers relied almost entirely on physical card catalogs, printed periodical indexes like the Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature, and microfiche to locate information. Finding a single journal article could take hours of manual searching through paper indexes, followed by a trip to the library — or an interlibrary loan request. The internet was in its infancy with minimal content.

The mid-to-late 1990s brought the first wave of change, as libraries began digitizing card catalogs into Online Public Access Catalogs (OPACs) and subscribing to electronic article databases like EBSCO and ProQuest. By the 2000s, full-text article databases, e-journals, and e-books had fundamentally altered the research process. Researchers could search thousands of publications simultaneously using keyword queries, access full articles from a desktop computer, and receive results in seconds rather than hours. Google Scholar, launched in 2004, further democratized academic searching by making scholarly literature discoverable. Access to full text articles still often depended on library or institutional subscriptions.

Today, library research bears little resemblance to its 1991 counterpart. Vast digital repositories, open-access publishing movements, and AI-assisted discovery tools allow researchers to synthesize literature at a scale that would have been unimaginable three decades ago. Librarians themselves have evolved into experts in data literacy, digital curation, and research methodology.

However, it is important to remember that although older journal articles and books may have been digitized, there are vast amounts of important scientific research, government reports and information by non-profit organizations that contain vast amounts of important, useful, and sometimes unique information to be found in scientific research and in the reports of government agencies and non-profit organizations.

Daniel Holmes' bibliography remains useful as it opens the door to a variety of data that will not be available digitally. You might find digital access to the full text of articles or federal or state government reports, but most of the items in this bibliography will only be accessible via paper.

Preface

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Introduction

The purpose of the bibliography is to give researchers a quick in-depth start on the Mono Lake Basin literature, regardless of their topic. The bibliography covers all aspects of the Basin's cultural and natural history and all types of documents including a few newspaper articles.

The ecological and legal significance of Mono Lake *per se* lends considerable value to the bibliography. However, it is about *all* the literature concerned with *any* aspects of the Mono Basin - an area of vastly greater proportions and blessed with immense ecological diversity. Indeed, Mono Basin is the meeting place, the area of intersection, of two great geologic and biologic provinces: the Sierra Nevada and the Great Basin. It extends in altitude over a range of six thousand feet, exhibiting a delightful and fascinating biological diversity. Concurrently it traverses the eastern escarpment of the Sierra, a dynamic land of earthquakes, uplift, and volcanoes. Spice is added in that this setting has spectacular vistas and a wonderful bird population. My personal favorites are the beautiful green grasses which offer a subtle accent to the landscape.

The availability and volume of Mono Lake Basin literature has benefited immensely from the public attention it has received during the last fifteen years. Many interesting items have been reprinted, making them available for the current generation. Water development in the basin, litigation and public outcry over the fate of spectacular Mono Lake, have led to unprecedented research, description, and analysis. And finally, authors, who would probably not have given any attention to an uncontroversial terminal lake basin, have been stimulated to study and write up their findings for us to enjoy.

The bibliography is organized in four major parts: the subject thesaurus, the subject index, the author/coauthor index, and the citations. They should be used together. Additionally, citations which read "in preparation" should be assumed to be from 1991 or later.

Use of the Subject Index and Thesaurus

Index terms are assigned to reflect the precise subject of the cited document. Thus, the index avoids redundant citing as well as redundant terminology. For example, an article on California gulls is cited only under that term. You will not find it listed separately under gulls, a superordinate term, or under birds, a superordinate term of gulls. Although this creates a certain inconvenience for the user, in that use of the thesaurus is essential, it provides for the complementary advantage of being able to locate documents with topical precision.

The subject thesaurus gives the reader the opportunity to analyze the relationships between the terms; for each term it describes the direct relationships to the other index terms. It also guides one from unauthorized terminology to the appropriate authorized index terms. It is essential that one uses the thesaurus.

The thesaurus allows the user to know which terms are superordinate and which are subordinate. Note that the arrangement is not strictly hierarchical. Thus, sometimes narrower terms are listed under a broad topic as well as a term subordinate to it: for example, **phalaropes** are listed as a narrower term under **birds** as well as under the subordinate term of **shorebirds**. For each Authorized term, the user is shown other directly relevant Authorized Terms which are *certain* to have additional citations. These include Broader Terms (designated as BT), Narrower Terms (NT), and Related Terms (RT). UF (used for) designates those unauthorized words for which the Authorized Term is used.

The reader should also reflect on the broad types of documents which would contain information relevant to their interests. For example, if one is interested in ecology, then environmental impact analyses should be examined. Again, the thesaurus addresses this problem by using the designation of RT for Related Terms, those authorized indexing words which will provide additional information usually relevant to the topic at hand.

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The use of place names in the Index is in a geographical sense: a name is meant to provide locational information about the document's contents, as opposed to indicating that the place *per se* is the subject of discussion. These were used conservatively. Mono Lake was not ever used, because so many documents have to do with it. Most documents which cover multiple places are simply not indexed to geographical names, it would be too confusing. For example, something on **stream studies and surveys** is almost certainly about some or all of the streams which drain the east side of the Sierra.
